- Season Long Catch Reports You must register for the Season Long Leader Board through the Reel Time App. This is the only way to submit catch reports for season long points. A link was sent out to you through Reel Time adding your boat if we had the name of your boat and your dues are paid. If not please email tournaments@capemaymarlintunaclub.com with your boat name, email of owner and owner's name. There is only one owner of each boat in Reel Time App.
- Participation in our CMMTC Tournaments is vital for the success of the Tournaments. With increased costs it takes a minimum of 14 boat base entry fees to cover the basic costs of food, banners, and additional staff for the captains meeting and awards dinner. The Board asks that your promote the tournaments and encourage others to fish them.

- ➤ CMMTC Member Dues are now considered past due and carry a \$100 late payment penalty. \$400 for angler member and \$500 for a family member. A reminder letter and email has been sent to anyone with past due dues. The past due list is kept with the bartenders and tournament directors.
- ➤ Challenge Cup is less than 2 months away. If you plan to fish your boat then you need to email your boat name, member name, date you plan to arrive and depart from OC, boat LOA, and boat width (beam) to tournaments@capemaymarlintunaclub.com prior to August 10, 2022 so the slips can be reserved for our member boats that are fishing the tournament. If you don't submit this by the date you will be on your own to arrange for the slip through whatever marina has room for you.

- Challenge Cup Captains Meeting will be held on September 2nd immediately following the Labor Day Overnighter Captains Meeting which starts at 7 pm. You must have a representative of your boat attend and all entry fees must be paid in full at the Captains Meeting.
- Challenge Cup 2022, to be eligible all member boats in good standing must have participated in two (2) CMMTC Sponsored tournaments in 2022 to fish the Challenge Cup. Challenge Cup 2022 will be a fish 2 of 3 days Captains Choice, Fishing Days are September 8th, 9th, and 10th. There will be no makeup week; If we are unable to fish at least one day the tournament will be cancelled. New Rule for 2022 is Omni Sonars may not be deployed until lines in.
- ➤ There are still a few events, tournament, and overall sponsorships for 2022. Sponsorship Packets for 2023 will be sent out in September 2023. For any questions and to sign up for a sponsorship contact the club at cmmtc@capemaymarlintunaclub.com
- The Board has approved repairs to first floor façade to repair rotted timber and enhance the appearance of the club. These repairs will begin in the fall 2022. It is anticipated that the club will be closed Monday thru Thursday the week of construction and reopen Friday night. As schedule is solidified, we will inform the membership.
