- Jul 1 and July 2 will be the 2022 Independence Invitational Tournament. Non club boats may fish for an additional entry fee. Categories are billfish releases (small board and large boat divisions), Tuna and Mahi. Awards dinner will be in conjunction with the July 3rd Celebration from 4 pm to 7 pm at CMMTC.
- July 29th from 7 to 10 pm we will be having a performer, Joe Yesulatis. To Quote Joe, "I'm not a veteran or a first responder, but I've come to realize that our safety and our very way of life depends on soldiers, sailors, police officers, firefighters and medical personnel. - The Reel Time App was used for the First two tournaments of 2022. Drum Tournament. It worked very well and is really easy to use. You must register your boat through the App in advance. Payment must be made in cash or check for base tournament entries. **Any additional tournament entries must be paid in cash only!**
- A Special Thank You to our Tournament Committee and especially Rachel Linus, Chair. This committee works long and hard in the offseason and during the season to put on quality events for the membership and this mostly goes without thanks. Please show them the respect that they deserve and acknowledge the effort that they and our staff put into every CMMTC tournament event. The Committee makes decisions with the best interest of the CMMTC and our members in mind. - Challenge Cup 2022, to be eligible all boats must have participated in two (2) CMMTC Sponsored tournaments in 2022. We have 9 tournaments throughout the fishing season which affords plenty of opportunity to qualify to fish the Challenge Cup if you desire. Challenge Cup 2022 will be a fish 2 of 3 days Captains Choice, Fishing Days are September 8th, 9th and 10th. There will be no makeup week; If we are unable to fish at least one day the tournament will be cancelled. New Rule for 2022 is Omni Sonars may not be deployed until lines in.
- The Board has approved repairs to first floor façade to repair rotted timber and enhance the appearance of the club. These repairs will begin in the fall 2022. This is the second of many needed Capital projects on the club building. The entire roof system was replaced over the Holiday Season at the end of 2021. The Board has prioritized a Capital Improvement List and is working on a 5-year plan to implement these long-needed improvements to our Club to present to the Oversight Board for approval.
- The Wreck Tournament will remain Captains Meeting on November 12th at 7 pm. Fishing will be on November 13th.

- The Guest sign in book is now located behind the bar. It is up to the member to ensure that their guests are signed in by the bartender every time they enter the premises. The guest book will no longer be accessible to anyone other than the Bartender on duty.

If you lose your card a replacement card will be issued after payment of the \$25 replacement fee. Access cards are not reissued annually.
