- The Reel Time App is not ready for download as is shown on the tournament Brochure but will be prior to the Drum tournament
- CMMTC will be rolling out a completely revamped sponsorship program for 2022. It will consist of General Sponsorships, Event Sponsorships and Tournament Sponsorships of varying levels. Details of this program have been sent out to prior CMMTC sponsors. They are now being sent out to Proprietary Members and Angler Members and then other area businesses in the next few weeks.
- The club parking lot shall not be utilized for vehicular parking whether a member or not when you are not actively using the CMMTC building.
- The dues discount period has expired. Remember your dues must be paid in full to utilize the club facilities and to attend club events. Dues paid after April 15<sup>th</sup> will incur the late fees. The previous new member recruiting incentive program has been eliminated effective Dec 31<sup>st</sup>.
- You may upgrade your membership to a family membership by notifying Halee in the office. Pay the family dues and provide the names of your spouse and children 21 to 26 years old. If you already paid your 2022 dues for an individual you would pay the difference to upgrade between individual and family.
- 2022 Membership cards are ready to be sent out to all members in good standing. There was a delay in getting them out this year but you should receive your card in the next week or so.
- Keyless Entry cards will be deactivated on April 16<sup>th</sup> for any members who have not paid their 2022 dues. Access cards for spouses that were issued previously to Proprietary Spouses and upgraded spouses on family membership will remain active. Otherwise, please return your spouse access card to receive your \$5 deposit back.
- If your key access card stops working please contact Halee in accounting and she can make a replacement for you to exchange for your non functioning card. If you lose your card a replacement card will be issued after payment of the \$25 replacement fee.
- Challenge Cup 2022, to be eligible all boats must have participated in two (2) CMMTC Sponsored tournaments in 2022. We have 9 tournaments throughout the fishing season which affords plenty of opportunity to qualify to fish the Challenge Cup if you desire.

- Challenge Cup 2022 will be a fish 2 of 3 days Captains Choice, Fishing Days are September 8<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup>. There will be no makeup week; If we are unable to fish at least one day the tournament will be cancelled. New Rule for 2022 is Omni Sonars may not be deployed until lines in.
- The Club is Open Tuesday thru Sunday from 4 pm to close. We have had to close due to weather so if inclement weather please visit the CMMTC Facebook page or call the club at 609.884.1006 to verify if the club is open.
