

### January 2023 President's Message

Merry Christmas, Happy Holidays and a Happy, Safe & Prosperous New Year to all the CMMTC members and families. CMMTC will be closed January 2, 2023 through February 9, 2023 for renovations.

- Front Façade Improvements & Lower-Level Renovations. Construction will start on the Façade and other improvements January 2, 2023. The Club will remain closed from January 2, 2023 through February 9, 2023. We are planning a Re-Opening Celebration Party for Friday Night February 10, 2023. The House Committee led by Christine Knight has put the most effort into making this a reality. We have been able to expand the scope of this project in January to add some cool upgrades that all members will immediately see and benefit from.

- Long Range CMMTC Facility Improvement Plan. The Board has approved the House Committee's long-term renovation and maintenance plans which are required to reinvest in our facility. CMMTC Board has worked hard to put the club in a sustainable financial position to allow these renovations to occur without any assessments, fundraising drives, or depleting club reserves. The 2022 roof replacement project; the front façade and the first-floor renovations are allowing us to complete some high priority items in the Plan.
- Wounded Warriors. \$1,002 was raised for Wounded Warriors on night Joe Yesulatis played. We have asked Joe to come back in 2023 and we hope to raise more in 2023; details to follow.

- 2023 Tournament Committee. The Tournament Committee and Board have approved the 2023 Tournament Schedule it is published and will also go live on the CMMTC Reel time App.

- Days of Operation. Club days of operation have been changed, the club will be closed every Monday to allow for maintenance, cleaning, and other activities. The club will be open Tuesdays from Memorial Day through Labor Day. These new days of operation go into in 2023.
- 2023 CMMTC Member Dues. Dues have been sent out via email. CMMTC will no longer mail out dues' renewals or membership cards. You may still mail check to the club or pay the bartenders directly. Starting January 1, 2023, once your dues are paid you will pick your membership renewal card up from the Bartenders during bar hours. After January 1, 2023, you may also pay the bartender directly cash, check or credit card and they will hand you your membership renewal card on the spot.
- Club Usage. Club bylaws permit members in good standing and their guests to utilize the facilities. A member is not in good standing until their dues are paid for the current year. After January 1<sup>st</sup> of each year your dues must be paid in full to enter the club. If you enter the club with non-current dues, you have must pay your dues on the spot or immediately leave the club until your dues are paid. Bartenders are responsible to enforce this policy without exception.
- Reel Time App Season Long Catch Reports. You must register for the Season Long Leader Board through the Reel Time App. This is the only way to submit catch reports for season long points and for 2023 to submit any catch reports for tournaments as well. You must use the Reel Time App. For the 2023 Season, you must use the app fully. We will not accept any tournament entries or catch reports by any method other than the CMMTC Reel Time App. All catch reports must have a legible photo of current CMMTC catch report uploaded for every fish. Make sure to include Boat and angler information including sex and if junior angler.
