Billfish, Tuna, Mahi, Black Seabass and Flounder are all the eligible species. Our members requested increased Optional Skill Prizes aka Calcutta's. The Tournament Committee has responded by adding them. Take special note of the additional categories of optional skilled prizes that can be entered.
- **Schools Out Tuna Tournament** – CMMTC, Jim's Bait & Tackle, Lobster House and South Jersey Tournaments have partnered to bring the Landing its first annual Schools Out Tuna Tournament June 21, 2023, thru June 26, 2023.
